10 YEARS OF THE INTERPARADIGMAS JOURNAL

The proposal for an academic journal that would bring together Conscientiology researchers with doctoral degrees was made on September 22, 2012, by Waldo Vieira during the symposium titled “*Analysis Tool*.” At that time, there were 16 individuals fitting this profile. By 2024, the number of such researchers worldwide has surpassed 120.

In the report *Interparadigmas Journal: Statement of the 1st Decade (2012-2022)* the team evaluated the outcomes of the journal based on nine aspects. The main achievement of the first decade was the establishment of the new specialty: Interparadigmology. During the first five years, the focus was on initiating editorial work, which in the second five years expanded to include courses, live sessions, and the formal proposition of the specialty.

The article *Interparadigmatic Text*, authored by members of the journal, identifies nine categories of texts derived from a meticulous review of all issues of the Interparadigmas journal up to issue 8. These interparadigmatic texts are, in ascending order: controversy, characterization, differentiation, comparison, interconnection, amplifying, bridge, integration, and interparadigmatic. The goal is to assist authors in writing their texts with greater clarity and systematicity.

Psychologist and conscientiologist Cristiane Gilaberte, a pioneer in earning a doctorate with a thesis exclusively on Conscientiology, was interviewed about the mutual influences between Conscientiology research and academic development. Throughout her academic journey, spanning from undergraduate studies through to her master’s and doctoral degrees, she encountered diverse forms of paradigmatic interaction.

Editors Cecília Oderich, Marina Vinha, and Vivian Brito documented their growth experiences within the journal’s editorial board, highlighting developments in cognitive, parapsychic, and personal and group existential programming fields.

This edition signifies a pivotal moment for the team. They engage in reflection to grasp the significance of a decade’s worth of work and achievements, thus equipping themselves to tackle the challenges of the forthcoming second decade.
