- Identification: title of the work, author's name, and institution.
- Abstract of up to 150 words.
- Up to 3 keywords.
- Mini-CV.
- The paper must be written in Portuguese, Spanish or English.
- APA citation style (template available at www.interparadigmas.org.br)

IV. Paper formatting:

- File format: doc, docx or equivalent.
- Paper size: letter.
- Line spacing: 1,5.
- Abstract (?) spacing: 1,0
- Margins: 2cm.
- Font: *Times New Roman* – size 12.
- Page numbers: top right corner
- Text length: between 25,000 and 50,000 characters.

V. Authorship requirements: At least one author must hold a PhD.
